AVPD: Thawed Time

In connection with Fotobiennalen 2018, Fotografisk Center presents a solo exhibition with new works by the artist duo AVPD (Aslak Vibæk and Peter Døssing). It is not a photo exhibition in the traditional sense, but in line with the Fotobiennale's theme concerning the post-photographic image, AVPD have turned photography inside out to explore and experiment with the idea of the photographic.

With *Thawed Time*, AVPD have investigated the photographic processes and have exposed them in an installational stage where time is no longer frozen in a "now" but with the sensational experience stretched out in space. The exhibition can thus be seen as a study of the photographic process and method as well as a challenging its representative nature.

Thawed Time present six new works in dialogue with selected former works, and can be seen as an overall statement that focuses on a particular optic of the AVPD artistic practice in and with its photographic focal point.

All the works are presented in a spatial staging that is specially adapted to Fotografisk Centers exhibition space in Kødbyen.

The exhibition is accompanied by a small catalogue with text by Charlotte Præstegaard Schwartz, PhD. In addition, Fotografisk Center provides teaching material and children's assignments.

In connection with the exhibition, the AVPD will talk at the Fotobiennale 2018 Symposium on August 31st and in October at a Vision Salon in collaboration with the Bikuben Foundation.
